LICENSING OF ENGINEERING FIRMS REGULATION

[10th Day of April, 2018]

Commence-
ment.

Pursuant to the powers conferred upon it by Sections 1(1)(d), 11, 21 and paragraph 2(1) of the First Schedule to the Engineers (Registration, etc) Act, Cap. E11 2004, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Council for the Regulation of Engineering in Nigeria (hereinafter referred to as "COREN") hereby makes the following Regulations—

1. Engineering Firms for the purpose of engineering practice shall be licensed on the basis of the following categories—

Categorization
of firms.

- (a) Consulting Engineering ;
- (b) Engineering Contracting ;
- (c) Engineering Manufacturing and Production ;
- (d) Engineering Service Provision ;
- (e) Vending of Engineering Machines, Equipment, Plants and Materials ;
- (f) Engineering Fabrication/Repair and Maintenance.

2. None of the above listed categories of firms or organizations shall practice in Nigeria without COREN Licence.

3.—(1) For the purpose of these regulations, all engineering firms are hereby classified as follows—

Firms
Classification.

- (a) Sole ownership
- (b) Partnership
- (c) Limited liability
- (d) Corporate ownership

(2) For the purpose of these regulations and licensing, engineering firms in category b-f are further classified into the following status.

Firms status
applicable
to categories
b-f.

- (a) Startup
- (b) Small N5million to N49.99million turn over
- (c) Medium N50million to N499million turn over
- (d) Large N500million upward turn over

4. The requirements for the issuance of licence to the Engineering Firms listed in Regulation 1 hereof shall be as follows—

Requirement
for licensing.

(1) An applicant for licence pursuant to these regulations shall submit the following :
